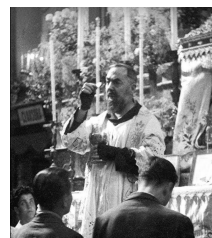

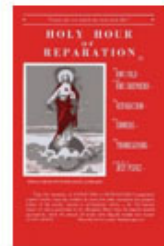

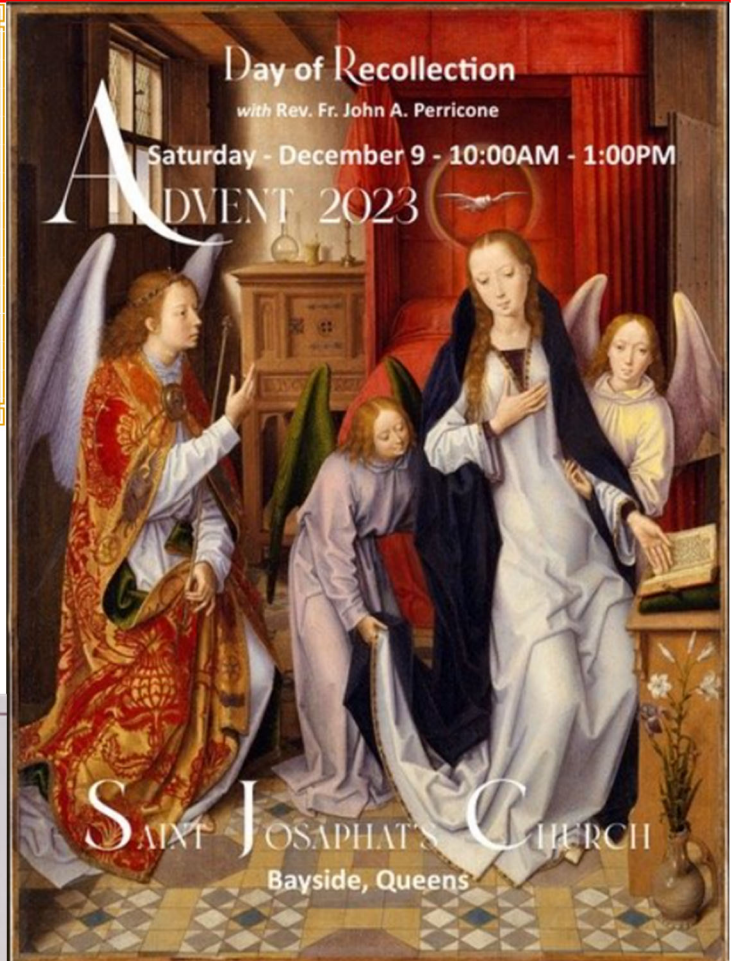

The **Right to Life Committee's** annual **BABY SHOWER FOR LIFE** is taking place from November 25 to December 10 for the benefit of **Bright Dawn Ministry**, founded by Sr. Dorothy Rothar.

The goals of Bright Dawn Ministry include the following:

- Save babies from abortion
- Assist their mothers, who many live in a situation of poverty and absent fathers
- Help the mothers spiritually and move their hearts back to God through conversion
- Counsel women who may have had past abortions

Sr. Dorothy performs sidewalk counseling outside abortion clinics, such as Choices in Jamaica, Queens and organizes monthly baby showers at St. Ann's Convent in Flushing for the women who listened to their hearts and chose life. Also, she arranges baptisms for the babies who have been saved (and in some cases their parents).

Please be generous and donate a baby shower gift by dropping it off in the **Baby Carriage of Love** by the side altar of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Much needed items include boys and girls clothes for sizes newborn to two-years old, baptism outfits for sizes newborn to three-years old, blankets, crib sheets, diapers, baby wipes, picture books, and educational toys.
