**Marriages:** Reserve and register date & time as soon as possible, at least six months in advance of the wedding. Pre-Cana and other instructional sessions are required for all couples.

**Sponsor letters:** Church law requires sponsors to be active, registered Catholics and live according to Church teaching

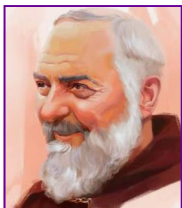
