Marriages: Reserve and register date & time as soon as possible, at least six months in advance of the

wedding. Pre-Cana and other instructional sessions are required for all couples.

Ministry to the Sick: Please call the Rectory.

NOTE: Sponsor letters: Church law requires sponsors to be active, registered Catholics and live according to Church teachings.

Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults (RCIA): Are you interested in becoming a Catholic? Please call the Rectory.






